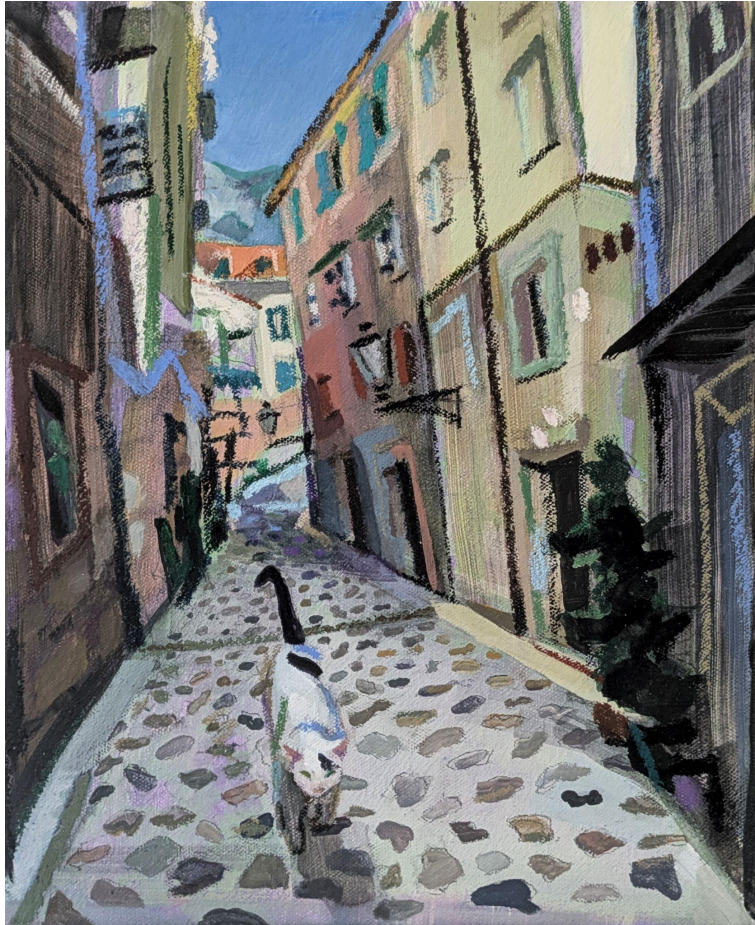

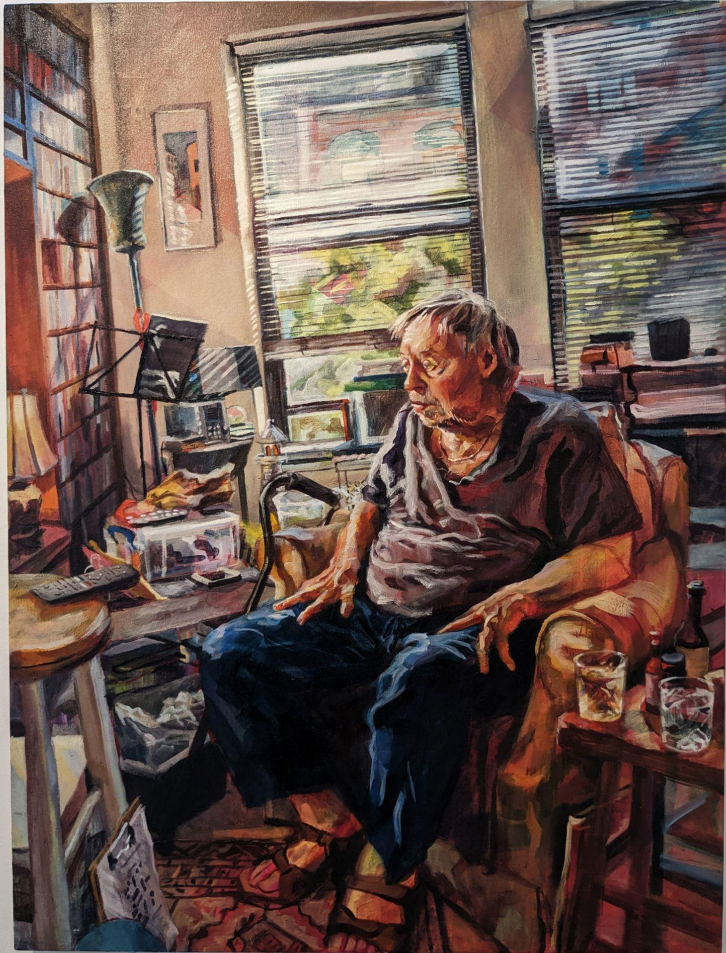

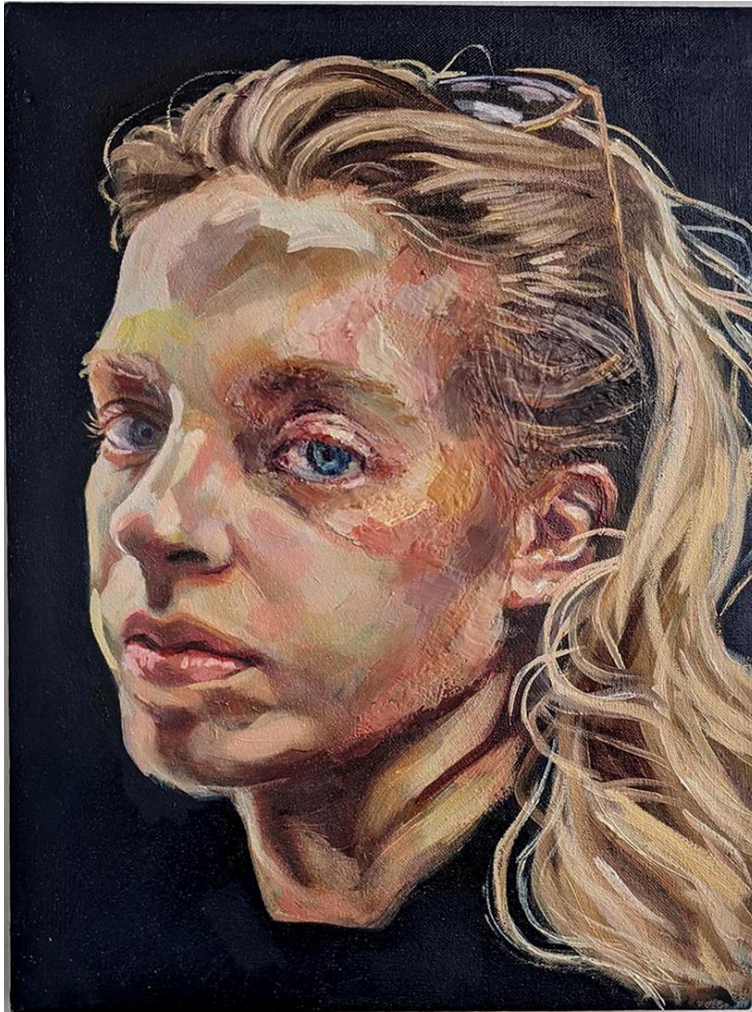


Angelique with Sunglasses

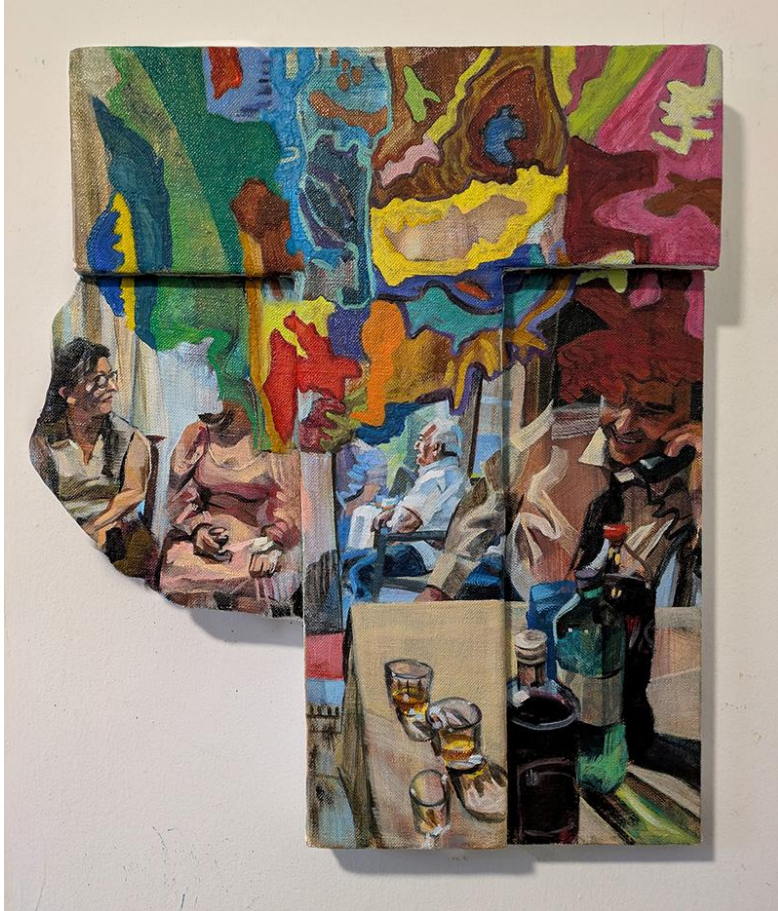
